



Alberta College of Family Physicians Recognition of Excellence Awards

The ACFP values the achievements and professional commitment of its members - medical students, family medicine residents, and family physicians - and is committed to supporting them in providing quality patient care through education, research, and promotion of best practices. Recognition of Excellence Awards will honour those members of the ACFP who have demonstrated outstanding qualities or contributions, and dedication to their patients, community, and / or the profession of Family Medicine.

Recognition of Excellence Awards will recognize ACFP members who in the past 12-24 months have made an outstanding contribution in a specific area pertaining to one or more of the following areas: Patient Care, Community Service, Hospital or Health Care Institutions, College Activities (National or Chapter), Teaching, Research, and other elements of the academic discipline of Family Medicine.

Examples of outstanding contributions may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Significant humanitarian work on a global basis
- Establishment of a training program in an area such as family violence
- Delivery of an educational program unique to the needs of a population at risk
- Excellence in clinical practice to disadvantaged communities, such as inner cities
- Leadership in primary care renewal projects, hospital, regional health care programs etc.
- Development of an innovative research project or program that contributes to the improvement of day-to-day clinical practice

Award Details

- Recognition of Excellence Awards will be given to a maximum of three (3) family physicians, one (1) Family Medicine resident and one (1) medical student each year.
- Recipients of the ACFP Recognition of Excellence Awards will be recognized and honoured by the ACFP at the Annual Scientific Assembly.
- All recipients will receive a framed certificate from the ACFP, complimentary registration to the Chapter's Annual Scientific Assembly, and one free night's accommodation during the Conference.
- Family physician recipients will also be recognized at the CFPC Family Medicine Forum.

Eligibility

- Can be nominated by a colleague or member of the public
- Nominees must be a member of the ACFP at the time of nomination
- Family Medicine Resident nominees must be registered in the Family Medicine Residency Program at the University of Alberta or the University of Calgary
- Medical student nominees must be enrolled at the University of Alberta or the University of Calgary

Process for Nomination

- Completed nomination form and supporting documentation to be sent to: Alberta College of Family Physicians, #370, 10403 -172 Street, Edmonton AB T5S 1K9
- Nomination form requires the signature of nominee and the nominator
- Only completed nomination forms will be accepted and submitted to the ACFP Nominations and Awards Committee for review
- The ACFP Nominating and Awards Committee will submit final recommendations to the ACFP Board of Directors for final review and approval.
