Member Survey 2014 Summary

- 7% response rate (more than double the 2012 member survey)
- 78% of respondents belong to a Primary Care Network
- Top three programs, activities, and initiatives you are aware of are: Tools for Practice, the Annual Scientific Assembly, and Advocacy work
- 79% of respondents rated programs, activities, and initiatives the ACFP provides are important
- 44% of respondents feel the single most important issue the ACFP should focus on is
 Advocating for the Family Physician role with the Alberta Government
- 64% of respondents feel the ACFP shouldLead the charge and drive the change we need to see in the health system
- Program content is the most important factor making a decision to participate in CPD/CME session
- Clinical workshops is the most valuable type of sessions you'd like to see at ACFP CPD events





- Keep advocating for the family physician




1. Tell us your gender (n=269)






2. Please select the age group you belong to (n=270)






3. The following best describes my current practice (n=255)






4. Check the Category which best describes the setting where you do most of your clinical work. (n=262)






5. I belong to a Primary Care Network (PCN) (n=266).






6. Describe the population PRIMARILY served by you in your practice. (n=268)






7. Are you aware of the mandate and purpose of the Alberta College of Family Physicians? (n=253)








8. Are you aware of the ACFP's programs, activities, and initiatives? (n=249)




9. Rate the importance of the programs, activities, and initiatives that the ACFP provides. (n=253)






10. Rate the importance of the advocacy efforts that the ACFP is involved in. (n=255)






11. As a member of the ACFP, what is your perception of the organization and its effectiveness? (n=254)






12. What issues do you feel are most important to family physicians in Alberta today? (n=253)




13. What is the single most important issue you'd like to see the ACFP focus on? (n=251)






14. How best do you feel the ACFP should represent family physician issues? (n=248)






15. Are you aware of the ACFP's advocacy work involving the government of Alberta and other health care stakeholders? (n=249)






16. Check the current ACFP collaborations you are aware of. (n=227)
